LEWANNICK PARISH COUNCIL

Met at Lewannick Parish Hall on Thursday 24th of
February at 8 p.m. Four members of the Public were
present at the commencement of the meeting. They were
led to believe that a site for a bus shelter had been
identified within Serpells Meadow. The Vice Chairman
assured them that 110 site had been negotiated within
Serpells Meadow and it was not the intention of the
Council to locate a shelter there. To find a location that
would have the approval of the Highways, NCDC and
most importantly the People of the Village, is a problem.
No site has been selected.

During the meeting it was agreed to ask the Highways to
move the 'unsuitable for lorries' sign at Meadow.
Highways will be asked to move it to the opening of
Meadow from the Village Green.
Residents of Trevadlock have requested national plate
signs. The Parish Council will purchase three signs at a
cost of £125. plus VAT each.
