Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant Village Hall on Thursday 23rd March at 8 I.m.

The Highways Agency held an exhibition in the car park beside Anthea's Country Cafe on Wednesday 22nd March when representatives from the Highways Agency and Cornwall County Council were on hand to answer any questions. Unfortunately we were not informed of this public consultation until it was too late to inform you all. Basically the Highways Agency is proposing to improve the junction of the A30 trunk road at Plusha. To improve **safety**, it is **necessary** to separate the crossing and turning traffic from the main **road** traffic. You can help. A copy of the proposed plan/questionnaire can be obtained by phoning 01392 312585. Any questionnaires can then be posted to the Highways Agency by Friday 28th April 2000. This consultation is an important step in developing the project and provides an opportunity for people to take part in the planning process.

Once again we have received a number of complaints about the **lack** of care by dog owners in the Lewannick area. It is notably serious around the paths leading to the **Primary** School. We have now informed the Dog Warden of our concerns. The Warden will be patrolling the area on our behalf. He will be looking to fine any offenders in order to stop this unsocial behaviour. A fine could be as much as £1000-00.

We are looking for a new Neighbourhood Watch Co-ordinator. Unfortunately, Cllr Iris Curley will be giving up this position. We are, therefore, looking for someone to fill this important post. If you would like any further information, or feel that you could assist our community in this way, please contact Iris at October, Medrow, Polyphant. We take this opportunity of thanking Iris for the work she has done as our Co-ordinator to date.
