The Annual Parish **Meeting** of **Lewannick** Parish Council was held on Thursday **25th** at 8 D.m.

The Chairllan reported that it had **been a** busy and successful year in which some key projects had been implemented. The bus shelter at Lewannick was an important and fUnctional addition to the Parish: work on the Parish clock would commence on Tuesday 30th of May; we are in consultation with CCC, with respect to speeding traffic through Lewannick. and hope to set up a partnership project with **CCC**; grants had **been** given to local groups including Polyphant Chapel and Lewannick Millennium Project at Lewannick School. We hope to renovate the War memorial. The general maintenance of the Parish is an ongoing consideration and in particular the work done **by** Mr. M. Cook last year in cutting the grass was to a very **high** standard. We have a new contractor this year.
