Lewannick Parish Council met on Thursday 27 July at 8.00 pm at
Lewannick Village Hall.

PLANNING: Bowden Derra, Polyphant. The application for
the erection of an assisted living unit (special care) represents a
departure from the development plan and has been referred to the
Secretary of State to give him the opportunity to decide whether the
application should be called-in for his own determination or
whether the Council should decide the application as they think fit.

No 1000/1076 Erection of Livestock Building, Tinney Hall,
Lewannick: Mr Tucker. We have supported this application.

No 1000/0968 Erection of porch and amended design 10 previously
approved game. Swallow barns, Trevadlock: Mr & Mrs NP
Edwards. We have supported this application.

No 2000/1036 Demolition of two holiday chalets, a redundant
toilet block and laundry unit and the erection of three park homes.
Trevadlock Hall Park, Congdon's Shop: Trevadlock Park Homes.
We have supported this application.

No 1000110SS Renewal of permission for the erection of two storey
extension and porch. Sunnybank, Polyphant: Mr & Mrs Haithwaite.
We have supported this application.

No 2000/0761 Mr & Mrs R G Barden, 13 Medrow. Approved by
NCDC.

Tree Work Within the conservation area at Coombe Farmhouse,
Polyphant. The County Forester does not object to the work
proposed being carried out, namely the felling of a Norway **Spruce**
which has a preservation order.

Informal Hearing re: Site at Trevadlock Manor, Lewannick: Mr
P Hall. We have previously supported this application for the
modification of condition no. 4 of decision notice no. 81/2462 to
enable the use of holiday cottages for winter let on land situated at
Trevadlock Manor, Lewannick.

Grass Cutting We have been extremely disappointed with the lack
of cuts carried out this year. This has been completely against our
wishes. We have selected another applicant and we are hopeful that
by the time you receive this newsletter it will have been cut.

Venue (or Council Meetings) In future meetings will be held 2: I.
i.e. two consecutive months at Lewannick followed by one month at
Polyphant. This is considered the fairest way because of the
greater proportion of the Parish who live in Lewannick & Trevadlock

Dog Fouling We are constantly receiving complaints about this. If
you are aware of someone who persistently allows their dog to foul
the area you need to report it to the dog warden at NCDC.

Photographic evidence would be required in order to prosecute but
perhaps a gentle guidance to the offender is all that is needed?

Footpath no 15, Lewannick Parish (The path by the stables,
Polyphant Green) An inspection of the site has been made by Mr
Monk, Senior Field Officer, CCC. It is believed that directing the
surface water into an existing ditch may cause problems with an
adjacent property. CCC are considering piping the water to a
nearby gully or alternatively **constructing** a channel along which
water can travel without eroding the path.
