LEWANNICK I)AIUSII COUNCIL met on

Thmrsday 19th October at Lewannick Village **Hall**.

Councillors had previously also attended a NCOC Local
Plan Consultation on the previous Wednesday when
Polyphant as a minor village was under review. Following
the meeting we have put forward the suggestion that as a
minor village we would recommend a separate satellite
boundary around Bowden Derm **House** to North Lodge.
We would also recommend that Trevadlock be incorporated
into the structure pion.

Councillors have investigated thoroughly the possibility of a
bus shelter in the heart of Trevadlock. Reluctantly the
conclusion is that there is no suitable site for a bus shelter
that would satisfy planning and highways. We have also
learnt that the previous car park opposite Ijolyphant Chapel
may become available. We are in communication with the
appropriate parties.

Councillors also attended a meeting by C C C at Lewannick
County Primary School on Thursday 26th October. At that
meeting the Councillors made C C C aware ortheir
concerns about traffic speeding through our Parish. As a
result of attending that meeting we **have** already received
confinnation in writing that Lewannick will be included on
next **years** programme as part of the County Councils speed
management policy in accordance with the County Councils
Local Transport Plan.
