- 1) Mr & Mrs Moore, Hollyvag, Lewannick: Additional use of existing site for tipping of waste and stone extraction for motor cycle practicing
- 2) Trevadlock park Homes: Demolition of 13 holiday chalets and siting of three park homes
- 3) Mr & Mrs D'Entrecasteaux: erection of a conservatory at I Serpells Meadow.

All three applications were supported by LPC

We have written to CCC, Highways with regard to:

- 1) Volume of surface water on the A30 from the Lewannick exit at Two Bridges
- 2) The lack of reflectors on the railings of Finches Bridge

We have also written to CCC for an urgent inspection of a sycamore tree situated outside of The Villa. Polyphant Green
