Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant on Thursday 25th January at 8.00 pm. There was one member of the public present at the start of the meeting when a discussion took place with respect to bus shelter provisions at Polyphant. It has been suggested that a Lynch gate outside the Chapel would be a highly desirable solution to the problem. The **Chairman** will be discussing the possibility with an architect who is sympathetic to buildings! surrounding landscape. C C C has recently carried out a survey of the trees on Polyphant Green. The survey has indicated that a lot of work needs to be carried out in the immediate future. Tenders were sent out to various contractors and it has been decided to invite Mr B Deighton from Polyphant to carry out the works over a two year period. A local enquiry will be held at the Guildhall, Launceston on Tuesday Feb. 13th at 10.00 am in which the applications by Mr & Mrs D Cash, Bowden Derra Park will be heard. Application no. 2000/1812 - Mr & Mrs M D'Entrecasteaux, erection of conservatory has been approved

We have agreed to participate in the Local Maintcncc Partnership for 2001/02 for the Public Path Network. We have decided on an option whereby our Council agrees to take the lead in looking after the Parish network of **rights** of way. We will detennine the level of maintenance in accordance with local needs and, ofcourse, eligible funding available.
