LEWANNICK PARISH COUNCIL Met on Thursday 28 Jun
at Lewannick Village Hall.

We have heard from BT that the telephone box in Polyphant will
be repainted in their financial year 2002/03

A number of parishioners are concerned about the increased
volume of vehicles that are parking on the roadsides within the
Parish. May we request that if at all possible you park off the
road please. Highways have also come back to us, following our
request for improvements to the road surfacing to Polyphant. It
is their opinion that the road does not need complete resurfacing
at the moment, however, we are pleased to see they are filling in
major areas. We will, of course, continue to request resurfacing.

A number of documents have been circulated to Councillors for
discussion. These included North Cornwall District Plan: First
Alteration; Cornwall Waste Local Plan revised Deposit Draft
and the North Cornwall Business Directory.

We are very sorry to have to report that two Councillors have
decided to resign their Office. They are both long standing and
hard working Councillors who will be greatly missed.

Councillor Pamela Haines from Hicks Mill and our Chairman
Councillor Neil Hobday. We wish to thank them for giving us
so much of their free time over many years.

As a result of the above resignations we have two vacancies. If
within 14 days of this advertisement a poll is requested by not
less than 10 local government electors for the Parish or
community, a bye-election will be held in order to fill the
vacancy. Otherwise the vacancies will be filled by the local
council itself by co-option of suitable persons qualified to serve
as a councillor as soon as practicable. Our next meeting will be
held at Polyphant Village Hall on Thursday 26 July when the co-
option would take place.
