LEWANNICK PARISH COUNCIL Met on Thursday 18th October at Lewannick Village Hall.

A30 two Bridges Picnic Site. We have received confirmation from CCC that their only proposal as part of the lay-by scheme is to stop the right hand turn from the A30 (eastbound) into the Lewannick Road. By closing the right turn, the proposed picnic site will be westbound only, and combined with clear definition of the junction area will make the location safer. From a recent plan it appeared that the whole A30 gap was to be stopped up but the fact is that the right turn will still be available to drivers from Lewannick who wish to access the eastbound A30.

Planning: No 2001/1639 Mrs D McCabe, Coombe Farmhouse, Polyphant. Listed building consent for general repairs and re-roofing of barn plus internal alterations to form annexe accommodation to Coombe farmhouse. Application was not supported because of an existing sewage embargo on the village.
