The committee would like to thank all of you who have supported and donated gifts to the events we have held so far - it should ensure that June 3<sup>rd</sup> will be a day to remember. Commemorative mugs made by our local potter will be given out on Friday May 31<sup>st</sup> to all the children who attend our primary school. Other eligible young people (0-18) will receive their mugs personally. Met on Thursday 18 April at Polyphant The meeting commenced at 8.00 pm and as always the first ten minutes of our meeting is made available for members of the public to come along and air their views. Three members of the public were present and a discussion on the progress of some form of bus shelter for Polyphant was discussed. We are at present awaiting written confirmation from CCC, Highways on the possible siting of a Lych gate outside Polyphant Chapel. It is essential that we have highways permission before any further progress is made. A flagpole is being made in time for the Jubilee celebrations and this will then be permanently sited outside Lewannick Village Hall. We received correspondence from a concerned resident about the amount of dog faeces continually being deposited on the Trelaske road, may we remind offenders that bins are provided. The letter has been forwarded to the dog warden.
