## LEWANNICK PARISH COUNCIL

The AGM OF Lewannick Parish Council took place at Lewannick Village Hall on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May. The Officers elected were as follows:

The accounts for the year ended 31.03.02 were presented by the Clerk. The fund balance stands at £6609.04. Expenses for the year amounted to £4231.06. Major expenses are planned for the coming year including the complete renovation of the War Memorial and a bus shelter for Polyphant (provided a suitable site is authorised)

General maintenance for the year ended 31.03.2001 included work on the trees on Polyphant Green £875, grass cutting £956.52, cleaning of bus shelter £86, clearance of footpaths £90 and Parish clock annual service £90.

A site meeting was recently held at Polyphant with the County Surveyor for highways to discuss the siting of the bus shelter at the present time we are still corresponding with development control and NCDC but it is hoped that further information will be available for our next meeting.

We have also been in correspondence with Friends of War Memorials. The experience corps are seeking Memorial sites which would benefit from volunteers practical assistance with tasks such as planting, tidying, landscaping, railing painting etc. We hope to incorporate their offer with our own restoration works. A number of documents are being circulated to the Cllr including NCDC Draft economic development action plan 2002/3 and NCDC Housing strategy.

Planning applications included No 2002/0914 Erection of dwelling and garage with biodisc mini treatment plant Galvay, adjoining Rivendell, Tinney Hill, Lewannick.

Mr & Mrs KJ Jones. Supported with a query over the proposed height of the building. No. 2002/061 Conversion of auction rooms and storage to doctors surgery. South west house, the Square, Lewannick, fully supported.

An inspection of the playground equipment at Polyphant has recently taken place by our insurers. They have recommended that a fence on the rear hedge towards Medrow needs to be installed. Also stones, rocks, tree debris etc. to be removed. We have asked Tim Ellis to carry out this work. Invoices for payment included B. Deighton (trees, Polyphant) £950.

Polyphant Methodist (hire of hall) £12, David Came £15.32. Atlas £57.57 for Union Jack & Cornish flag together with pulleys. Cornhill insurance £314.64. Copytech (newsletter) £3. £250 to jubilee ref NCDC grant. A flagpole will be in place at Lewannick in time for jubilee celebrations.

Next meeting Lewannick Village Hall Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June at 8.00 pm, as usual members of the public are welcome.
