## LEWANNICK PARISH COUNCIL

Met at Polyphant on Thurs. 20 June at 8.00 pm. NCDC have written confirming that a bus shelter can be built on the village green at Polyphant. The shelter will be sited and designed to take into account the special character of the green. We have now asked for plans to be drawn up and will have the plans available for inspection soon. We have also instructed Mr Glynn, a monumental mason to commence work on the war memorial. We have requested Bruce Deighton to look at the trees in and near the play area in Lewannick. Following his report we have instructed him to carry out formative pruning and selective felling in order to allow trees to grow to maturity. Invoices were passed for payment for Ben McManigan £500 – jubilee mugs, T & S ellis £80 – Polyphant play area maintenance, David Jones - £90 maintenance of Parish Clock, BJU £22 – cleaning of bus shelter and £30 copytech – printing newsletter. The following planning applications have been supported:

Mr & Mrs N Ponting, land adjoining Dingleys, Lewannick, erection of a dwelling., Mr & Mrs A Jones, Galvayne adjoining Rivendell, Tinney Hill, Lewannick – erection of dwelling and garage with installation of Klargester Biiio-disc mini treatment plant. On the above tow applications our concerns of the overall height have been raised. Mr & Mrs D Cash, North Lodge, Bowden Derra alterations and extensions. Mr D Whitaker 37 Hawks Tor, extension to garage to provide larger garage and utility room. Conversion of auction rooms and storage to doctors surgery. South west house, the Square, Lewannick, fully supported.
