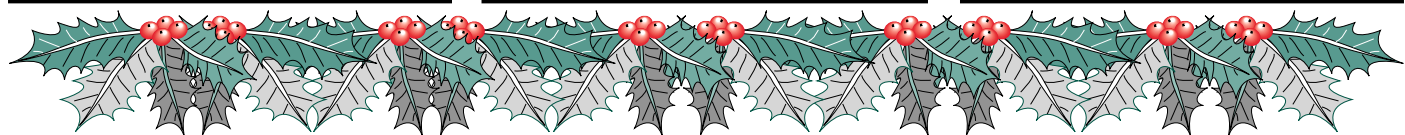

PARISH COUNCIL

Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on Thursday 20 November at 8.00pm. Our Police Liaison Officer, Cllr Iris Curley, gave a report following a meeting she had attended recently in Launceston. There is a new non-emergency police contact number 0845 2 777 444, calls to be charged at local rate.

We are pleased to report that the missing sign for Example Cross is now back in situ. We have also been corresponding with C C C with regard to Blaunders Well following an enquiry from a local resident. The path is not recorded as a Public Right of Way on the Definitive Map and therefore CCC is unable to spend public money on maintaining it nor can we as a Parish Council. As we have investigated the access and the monument is on private land it is up to the discretion of the owner to allow access.

Planning applications, all of which were supported, comprised Mr K Mead, The Hollies, Polyphant: Erection of detached garage, Trebartha Estates Ltd, Trevadlock Farm, Congdon Shop: erection of additional bay to approved agricultural building and Mr R F Werring Land adjacent to Southwest House, Lewannick: erection of single dwelling.

For information Erection of single storey extension at Medrow Bungalow, Polyphant - Mr Ellis: Refused. Mr N and Mrs J Potter, Mount Pleasant, Medrow erection of lean-to extension - approved. Mr M T Sobey, Tinney Hall Cottage, Lewannick: Erection of conservatory to south elevation - approved. Mr N Davey, Tremarvey Barn, Trenthorne: Erection of first floor extension to provide additional bedroom: approved.

The precept for the year April 2004 - March 2005 was reviewed and payments for the years 2002, 2003, 2004 together with projections for 2005 were supplied by the Clerk. After discussion it was agreed that the precept for a Band D property within our parish has been set at £31.54 for the year to 2005 Invoices presented for payment included Copytech £30 and Bntish Legion £14.50.

Our Community Governor Cllr J Newbery reported how the children from the school enjoyed planting the bulbs around the War Memorial. Our Chairman commented how very well attended the Remembrance Service was and he thanked everyone who had contributed to the afternoon tea that followed. The final meeting for this year will be held at Lewannick on Thursday 18 December at 8pm. The first ten minutes of our meetings are always open to the public for general discussion.

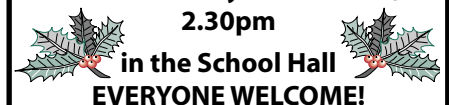
