PARISH COUNCIL

Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant on Thursday 15 January. Planning for discussion included the formation of new 70 metres squared foundation extension for Lewannick Community Primary School, which was supported.

Applications that have now been approved by NCDC included Mr and Mrs D Cash, North Lodge, Polyphant. Mr T Harris erection of detached dwelling land South of Medrow, Polyphant. Lewannick Village Hall Committee new entrance and disabled persons ramp access and disabled persons toilet extension and Trebartha Estates Ltd for the erection of additional bay to approved agricultural building.

NCDC have also written to us with regard to Council Tax and Second Homes. The Council have yet to make a formal decision but it is expected that it will be determined at the end of this month and the discounts on second homes may be reduced from 50% to 10% and discounts will be removed possibly on long term empty homes altogether. Cheques for payment were made to BJV £22.00 (cleaning of bus shelter) and Copytech £30 for the newsletter.

We are also notifying Highways about the condition of a number of the roads within the parish.

Our next meeting will be held at Lewannick on Thursday 19 February at 8pm. Members of the public are always welcome and are free to speak about any concerns at the commencement of our meetings.

Whitmans Weather

As we enter a new year in weather terms, readers might like to be reminded that all rainfall figures quoted for a particular month are in fact for the period of Newsletter copydate to the following copydate ie from around 25th to 25th each month.

Bearing in mind that copydate for the Christmas Newsletter was slightly earlier than usual and that the last few days of 2003 were particularly wet (to say nothing of the 7th/8th this month !!), the following figures should not come as a total surprise - although at least three times greater than recorded by a relative in Buckinghamshire!

Dec/Jan 03/04 - 4 dry days 210 mm (approx 8.25 inches) rainfall .. compared to 13 dry days and 181 mm rainfall last year.

So we seem to have started off on the wrong foot in my book! Let's hope that a drier spell is on it's way - although by the time this report gets into print, melting snow may have had a significant impact!!

Mount Kilimanjaro Challenge

An article appeared in the Cornish Guardian on Thursday 8 Jan 04 under the heading

Woman's New Year Challenge.

"A woman has set herself a New Year challenge to climb Mount Kilimanjaro. Mrs Yvonne Mansell aged 48 of Trewen Launceston will be flying out on 30 January 04 with a group of others who are helping the Anthony Nolan Trust, which raises money for stem cell Leukaemia research.

Mrs Mansell decided to undertake the trek after her husband died unexpectedly last year.

Mrs Mansell said that although her husband's death was not connected with Leukaemia she had lost a couple of members of her family through the disease. 'I have been to Kenya and have seen the mountain and I thought I would like to do this before I am to old', said Mrs Mansell. If not affected by altitude sickness, Mrs Mansell says it should take four days to walk up Mount Kilimanjaro and two days to get down."

"I have been walking through the lanes of North Cornwall and training at the Sports Centre in Launceston", said Mrs Mansell. She has already raised £2000 for the Anthony Nolan Trust and hopes to raise a further £1500.
