## Road safety

There have been a few near misses reported to me recently in the lane leading to Trevadlock Hall Park by people, particularly the elderly, walking in the lane and speeding motorists. I have contacted Highways about the problem of speeding locally. People walking any of the lanes must help to protect themselves and be visible to motorists by wearing High Visibility clothing. If they do see motorists speeding in the lanes try to take their registration numbers so they can be prosecuted for driving without due care and attention.

If walkers can be SEEN then the motorists have NO excuse for not slowing down.
