Lewannick Parish Council News

Lewannick Parish Council did not hold a meeting during August. However, we wish to ensure that you are all aware of the introduction of the "dial-a-ride" Community Bus that is planned to be introduced to serve some of the least accessible villages around Launceston.

There is still a lot of work to be done to get the bus on the road and to keep the service running on a day-to-day basis and the Launceston Community Transport Partnership are looking for help. If you feel that you could help in any of the following areas:-

- **Organising Routes** (Consulting on proposed routes, driving the proposed routes to check suitability and timings)
- **Publicising the service** (eg. contacting the papers, magazines and local radio stations, talking to groups such as the WI etc.)
- **Fundraising** (eg. holding coffee mornings, running cake stalls, applying for grants, funding and sponsorship)
- **Administration** (eg. taking bookings, ensuring drivers are available, keeping records, preparing tax reclaim documents)
- **Running the Bus** (driving it, cleaning it, refuelling it).

Do you have other skills that could be used? Can you spare even one hour a month or more, to help? The Committee will be meeting on Monday 15 September at Eagle House Hotel, 2.00pm for a 2.30pm start and if you feel you can help in any way please come along. There will be a display so you can see what has happened so far and also to give some information about other Community Bus Groups around Cornwall.

In the meantime, if you would like to help with the Community Bus and could help in any of the aforementioned tasks please write to Sam Cleeve, ECRT Project Officer, NCDC, 3-5 Barn Lane, Bodmin, PL31 1LR or leave your name and any information regarding what you could do to help at the Launceston Tourist Information Centre in Market House Arcade.
