Lewannick Parish Council News

Lewannick Parish Council met on Wednesday 17 September at 20.00 hours. The venue was Lewannick Village Hall. Matters discussed included Footpath 17 between The Cottage and The Stables, Polyphant. The condition of the path has been forwarded to the County Council to ensure access for walkers is available.

There will be a Liaison Meeting with reference to Blackhill Quarry on 8 October.

We are pleased to confirm that planning permission has been granted for the ongoing maintenance of the trees in the conservation area, Polyphant. We now invite tenders from any tree surgeons with public liability insurance to contact us for a tender pack.

We have also received the grant funding for a swing at Polyphant together with a noticeboard for Lewannick and we are actively obtaining quotes before going to contract.

There was one planning permission for consideration, namely 3 Hawks Tor Drive, Lewannick, Mr R Butler, No. 2008/01656 which has been supported. There were two planning applications that have been approved by NCDC, Mr and Mrs Haithwaite, Sunnybank, change of use of industrial building to residential bungalow and Mr M. Newbery, Bramble Park, Lewannick, conversion of garage into a study.

Invoices for payment included Helena Novak production of newsletter £262.50, J R B (Dog Bin, Trevadlock) £246.75, Perfect Pastures £1,113.31 and £29.97 ARB office.

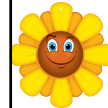
