## Lewannick Parish Council News

Our AGM was held on Wednesday 20 May 2009 at Lewannick Village Hall. Our Chairman, John Newbery for the ensuing year, was unanimously re-elected together with our Vice Chairman Adrian Brown. The Chairman gave his report for the previous year and this was followed by our financial report. Our balance in hand as at 31 March 2009 was £6,661. Expenditure for the year totalled £10,936, and this incorporated the maintenance of Lewannick and Polyphant Greens £3,453, newsletter £728, Audit Commission £182, dog bin Trevadlock £247, grants to various organisations within the parish £846, insurance £555 and the purchase of a swing for Polyphant £3,008. Various organisations in the parish gave their annual reports. This is helpful for us to discover where grant funding would best be placed for the forthcoming financial year. Following the AGM our Ordinary Meeting commenced.

There were many queries raised concerning Highways and it was agreed that we would invite a representative from Highways to our next meeting. With regard to Polyphant Green it is understood that some members of the parish have been querying the spraying of the northern boundary of Polyphant Green. A report was carried out in February 2008 and it was recommended that the weed Petasites which is present in the northern boundary and in the area between trees 20 and 29 of our plan be eradicated by poison. An herbicide recommended by our County Forester has been sprayed in the hope of eradicating this weed. Petasites is very invasive and will, if left, suppress other flora and even grass. Our plans had been well published prior to the work being commenced and, of course, we obtained planning permission before any works were carried out. We are also concerned that there has been fly tipping of grass cuttings onto the green. This, of course, is an offence and an offender risks being fined quite substantially for committing such an act. We have also had concerns raised regarding the erection of signs on the Green which again is not permitted. The Green is an open space that is preserved for the enjoyment of all.

We are hopeful that we can create a parish plan in the near future. In order to make an informed decision we are inviting the Community Planning Manager of Cornwall Rural Community Council to our next meeting to explain the community planning process, its purpose and benefits. It is hoped that once we have a community plan in hand we will be able to obtain

further grant funding for community-led projects. It is hoped that members of the parish would like to help us to carry out this plan and if you would be interested in helping your community please come along to our next parish council meeting to find out the benefits of working together to create a plan which will assist our parish in the future.

THERE WERE CONCERNS REGARDING THE PRESERVATION OF OUR HERITAGE. 2009/00564 – revised design to previously approved application under 2007/00146 for the erection of a dwelling namely erection of wooden balcony at rear of property with walkway to garden and replace windows in master and bedroom two with French doors – DARKES FARM, POLYPHANT – Mr Nick Evans: SUPPORTED. 2009/00567 – Application for prior notification for the siting of an agricultural shed for the storage of hay and straw – North Downs, Polyphant, Mrs Shirley Jasper: SUPPORTED IN PRINCIPLE BUT CONCERN ON SIZE AND A NEED FOR A BETTER DESCRIPTION OF FUTURE USE. 2009/00610 – Change of use from domestic to residential care home – Penn-Inney, Lewannick, PL15 7QD – Mr L Difford: SUPPORTED. 2009/00603 Application for Prior Notification for the construction of 2 No. agricultural storage barns LAND AT TRENHORNE, CONGDON SHOP, Ms Debra Richardson: NOT SUPPORTED: CONSIDERED TOO BIG IN THE MIDDLE OF NO WHERE.

Applications received for information: 2009/00172 Mr Ian While, Plusha, erection of a potting shed, greenhouse and drying bay – APPROVED. CCC – Lewannick Primary School – Phase 1 – extension to existing school to form new staff facilities and entrance – APPROVED. Mr A Brown – 3 Springfield, Trevadlock- removal of existing store/study and erection of extension to provide new kitchen/utility and bedroom – APPROVED. Mr and Mrs O Withers – The Warren, Polyphant – erection of single storey extension comprising bedroom with en-suite shower room – APPROVED. Ms D Richardson – erection of agricultural dwelling and garage together with barn and polytunnel – REFUSED. Mr S Penhale – Charmwell, Lewannick – Erection of extension to side of dwelling and alterations – APPROVED. There was one invoice for payment, namely £948.75 Arien Signs for the supply of an oak glazed case notice board. We have also ordered an oak glazed lectern for the display of the parish footpath map which will be located at Lewannick.

There being no further business the Chairman declared the meeting closed. Our next meeting will take place in Polyphant on Wednesday 17 June. During this meeting the parish plan will be discussed. Grants will also be awarded to various organisations within the community following their presentations to us at our A G M. If your organisation did not submit a report but would like to be considered for grant funding from L P C please submit your application to us before our next meeting. Our meeting will commence at 20.00hrs.
