## Lewannick Parish Council News

Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village hall on Wednesday 15 July. The meeting commenced at 20.00 hours. Our new County Councillor, Phil Parsons, was in attendance and this gave the council an opportunity to discuss the many outstanding matters with regard to Highways. A site survey of the parish has taken place with Cllr Phil Parsons and it is hoped that issues may be brought forward soon. It is noted that a number of the hedgerows adjoining the highways are overgrown and owners are reminded that on the point of safety it is important that the hedgerows are trimmed back.

There was one planning application for discussion, namely, Application No 2009/00893 Two storey extension with a single storey glazed link between existing building and proposed extension, LONGCROFT, CONGDONS SHOP - Mr Gill - which has been supported.

There was one invoice for payment of £1,089.63 to Perfect Pastures for the maintenance of the village greens and footpaths.

We have a further meeting on Wednesday 29 July when we will meet a member of staff from Cornwall Rural Community Council to discuss the benefits of carrying out a parish plan.

Our next ordinary meeting is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 16 September 2009 at 20.00 hours.
