Lewannick Parish Council News

We met at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 21 October at 20.00hours.

There were two planning applications for consideration, namely, 2009/01381 South Cottage, Trevadlock Cross, Lewannick, Mr and Mrs Fisher. Proposed two storey extension with glazed link. This was supported. Application 2009/01344 replacement dwelling incorporating main elements of existing dwelling Trelaske Manor, Trelaske, Mr T Z Doak. This application was not supported – the application will be going to committee. For our information application number 2009/01066 Mr John Preston – Trelydia House has been approved for the demolition of existing stone shed and construction of a single storey extension.

We raised our concerns regarding the publication of planning notices. Applications are currently not advertised within the Cornish and Devon Post and we have requested that this be reconsidered. We have also raised our concerns regarding the erection of notices. These used to be pink and are now a cream colour which is not so easy for residents to notice. We urge all residents to please be vigilant and check for any cream planning notices that are displayed at properties.

We had two invoices for payment, namely, Perfect Pastures £1,060.88 for the maintenance of parish greens and footpaths and £45.00 for the repair of gate at Lewannick Playing Area to T & S Ellis.

We also have had a meeting with Blackhill Quarry and there is a planned meeting at Altarnun Village Hall regarding the junction at Plusha.

Our next ordinary meeting will take place at Lewannick on Wednesday 18 November 2009 commencing 20.00 hours.

Telephone Box

We are in the process of adopting the red telephone box at Polyphant. We feel, as a council, that it is important to preserve our heritage. The public telephone kiosk is a familiar sight on our streets and we wish to preserve our box in Polyphant.



The familiar red colour was chosen so that it would be easy to spot and was a result of a competition in 1924 to design a kiosk that would be acceptable to the London Metropolitan Boroughs which had hitherto resisted the Post Office's effort to erect kiosks on their streets.

The Royal Fine Art Commission was instrumental in the choice of the British standard kiosk. The winning design was selected by the Commission, the Post Office and The Birmingham Civic Society and they selected the design submitted by Giles Gilbert Scott. The Post Office chose to make Scott's winning design in cast iron and to paint it red (Scott had suggested silver, with a "greeny-blue" interior) and it was brought into service as the Kiosk No 2 or K2. The kiosk became a familiar sight from 1926.

Wrought Iron Signage

As you walk or drive throughout our parish you will observe three wrought iron signs. We are hoping with your assistance to preserve these too. We are in communication with our County Councillor, Phil Parsons, together with Highways. It is hoped we can come to an arrangement with Highways so that they will give us the materials in order to repair and reinstate the signs. We are looking for people within the parish who may wish to assist us with this project. If you feel you could help in the restoration of these ancient signs please contact one of our Councillors.
