

# Lewannick, Polyphant & Trevadlock Newsletter

## Lewannick Parish Council News

We met at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 17 March 2010. There were three planning applications for consideration, namely: 2010/00281 Demolition of existing lean-to side garage and replacement with carport and conservatory, The Hive, Polyphant, Ms Catherine Thornhill and 2010/00282 Application for listed building consent for demolition of existing lean-to side garage and replacement with new car port and conservatory, The Hive, Polyphant. These applications have not been supported our concerns being the restriction of access. Application No 2010/00313 Application for Prior Notification for replacement of 2 dilapidated barns with 2 stone built barns. Bowden Derra, Polyphant, Mr D Cash has been supported. There is also a special meeting scheduled with Richard White, Planning, when he will give us further guidance on planning and explain his role. This will be held in conjunction with neighbouring parish councils.

With respect to Polyphant Green/play area we are in the process of removing the two park benches because they are unfortunately beyond repair. We have also carried out minor repairs to the play area at Polyphant.

There was one invoice for payment, namely £27.50 for the hire of Polyphant Hall.

We have responded to an enquiry from CC with regard to tackling long term empty properties – a wasted resource. If any residents are aware of properties within the parish that have been empty long term please let us know.

We are planning an Open Meeting in which we are inviting residents throughout the parish to bring along any historical documentation they have relating to the parish. If any of you have information that we can use for this meeting please contact us.

Residents may be interested to learn that the Parish Clock was gifted in memory of parishioners who gave their lives during the First World War. It would be useful if any relatives of these people could contact us. We are in the process of applying for grant funding to make the parish clock a self-wind mechanism. This would avoid someone having to climb up the tower and wind the clock on a regular basis.

Finally, we have a meeting with Oliver Jones (Highways) and C Cllr Phil Parsons scheduled for an inspection/site visit of the various highway matters that have been brought to their attention throughout our parish. Our next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday 21 April 20.00hours at Lewannick Village Hall.

### Seats on Polyphant Green

We have recently removed two old and broken seats on the green. We are planning to replace these shortly. We are currently researching seats which will be fitting to the location, long lasting and requiring minimal or no maintenance. We expect these to cost in the region of £650 - not cheap, but for something that will last for 10 years plus, a sensible use of

our resources. We are also investigating grants to help with this. If you might be interested in donating a seat in memory of someone - with an engraved plaque - please do contact us.
