The Annual Parish Meeting took place on Wednesday 19 May 2010. The Council were pleased to re-elect John Newbery as our Chairman and to re-elect Adrian Brown as our Vice Chairman. Both were happy to accept their positions. There were no planning applications for discussion, however, it is noted that approval has been granted for Listed Building Consent for the demolition of existing lean-to side garage and replacement with new carport and conservatory, The Hive, Polyphant.

There were two invoices for payment, namely Homeleigh Garden Centre for two teak park benches £1,016.00 and B J V Cleaning £22.00 for maintenance of bus shelter, Lewannick. There will be a conference on 4 June 2010 at the Eden Project on Renewable and Low Carbon Energy in Cornwall to which we will be sending councillors to represent us. Launceston Forum Consultation Event on 25 May will also be represented by Councillors from our parish.

Our next meeting is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 16 June 2010 commencing 20.00 hours at Lewannick Village Hall. As always members of the public are most welcome to attend.

FIREARMS COMPLAINTS

Due to a high volume of complaints from residents in Altarnun, regarding youths carrying air weapons in a public place, I would like to take this opportunity to make people aware of current legislation regarding the use of Air Weapons in a public place.

It is an offence for a person under 18 to have an air weapon or ammunition in a public place (this also covers firearms) unless they are supervised by someone over 21 years of age.

It is an offence for a person while he has a firearm or imitation firearm to enter or to be on any land as a trespasser without a reasonable excuse.

It is an offence if a person over 21 years, whilst supervising a person under 18 years, allows them to fire a missile beyond those premises.

Regarding the complaints we received from the members of the public, the youths concerned have been identified and they have been dealt with by being issued with a stage two warning letter as part of the Anti-social behaviour procedure.

Could I ask all residents to be vigilant and if they see anybody with firearms, and they are concerned, to call the police in the normal manner so that we can address the situation and improve the quality of life and deal with the offenders in a positive manner.

"Independent Custody Visiting" is a well established system in which volunteers attend police stations to check on the treatment of detainees and to ensure rights are being observed. The importance of the Independent Custody Visitors cannot be understated. Visits are unannounced, can occur at any time of the day or night and reports of the visits go directly to the Police Authority offices in order that action can be taken.
