## Lewannick Parish Council News

Our meeting took place in Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 16 June. A discussion with respect to the new homes within Lewannick formed a large percentage of the meeting. Local residents who are trying to apply for a property are unhappy that neighbouring parishes are eligible to receive an affordable home on the same basis as local residents who have lived within the parish and naturally wish to remain. We have requested a priority flag for all applicants from Lewannick, Polyphant and Trevadlock. This is not legally binding, but with the assistance of our County Councillor Phil Parsons, we are constantly voicing our concerns and are putting pressure on Coastline to give local residents priority.

We have also received a tree maintenance report and have submitted a planning application for some works that are deemed necessary.

Invoices for payment included £848.94 Perfect Pastures for maintenance works to Polyphant and Lewannick Greens, Bruce Deighton £525.00 for report on Polyphant Green and £315 for half yearly payment of newsletter publication. We also awarded grants to Launceston and District Over 50's, Lewannick Church, Polyphant Church, Trevadlock Cemetery and the Lewannick website.

Our next meeting will be held at Polyphant on Wednesday 21 July commencing at 20.00 hours.

### LITTER GROUP FOR LEWANNICK

Lewannick is joining a number of local parishes in tackling the problem of unsightly litter "decorating" roadsides and public places. Parish Councillor Michael Cook has taken the initiative in setting up a group who will comb the verges on a regular basis. At an inaugural

meeting recently ten volunteers were given basic training and equipment by our Cornwall Council Street Ranger Rodney Hancock. It's important that anyone working with the group is not a danger to themselves or other road users. By following a few common sense rules and by wearing hi-viz jackets litter picking on minor roads can be carried out safely and effectively.

If you would like to help we would urge you for your own safety to join the group rather than go it alone. We're taking a positive attitude and saying to everyone 'let's take a pride in our parish and see just how clean and litter free we can make it'. We have the backing of Rodney Hancock, whose team will deal with litter on major and busy roads, and will remove any larger items.

We agreed that future incidents can be reported directly to the police on the 08452 777444 number, with the caller getting a **log number and date** from that number. I can also be contacted on 782493 and if I am contacted, I will get in touch with a NHW member to visit the caller for moral or other support. If this is the case, I or my nominee, may discuss the progress of the incident with the police, and contact the caller.

The police will continue to email Jenny Potter and myself to advise us of current news. The 08452 777444 number can be rung to report incidents other than criminal actions, such as road traffic offences or domestic violence, or any matter which the caller wants to discuss with the police. Whatever the cause of the call, the police will advise the caller and, if action is to take place, once again the caller must get the **log number and date**.
