Lewannick Parish Council News

We met at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 21 July at 20.00 hours. Our meeting began with a minute's silence as a mark of respect of Cllr Ken White. Ken was an excellent local and county councillor who worked with loyalty and integrity for the people of the parish and district. He was an incredible asset to our parish council with a wealth of local knowledge. He certainly made his mark and will be deeply missed by us all. Our thoughts and love are extended to Betty and family.

We had one planning application which was supported, namely, CC – PA10/03801 Mrs M Kemp extension to existing school to form new foundation unit, Lewannick Community Primary School, Hawks Tor Drive, Lewannick. We also had in attendance a representative from Lewannick Pre-School/School, Helen Ward, who gave a presentation on a proposed project which again was supported in writing by us.

We had one invoice for payment, namely Perfect Pastures £235.00 for maintenance of the public footpaths.

We now have a vacancy on the parish council for a councillor. If you would be interested in helping the community in this way please contact any councillor or clerk for further information. We would be very pleased to hear from you.

We have had confirmation from the Carnewater Practice that it is their intention to go ahead as planned with the new surgery. The matter is currently with solicitors, and once the legal matters are agreed and the contracts, finalised, the building will go ahead in Lewannick. They had hoped to be in their new premises by now, but are hopeful that the contracts will be finalised shortly.

Finally there is no meeting in August. However, we will be carrying out research for Lewannick Play Area in the hope of organising plans for new equipment which will, of course, be subject to grant application. Our next parish meeting will take place in Lewannick on Wednesday 21 September commencing 20.00 hours.
