## Lewannick Parish Council News

We had no meeting during August although Cllrs have been active on a number of issues including the new development at Harpers Meadow. A "meet and greet" day took place recently for Cllrs and new tenants. We are also actively engaged with neighbouring councils with respect to Low Cost Housing for Local Needs. Our next meeting is scheduled to be held at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 22 September commencing 20.00 hours.

We are, as we hope you are aware, looking for a new councillor to join us. If anyone is interested please contact us. We will be pleased to hear from you.

We have been reminded that Cornwall Council need to make us all aware that the landfilled site at United Mines near Redruth will close at the end of October and then all of the waste generated in Cornwall will be taken to Cannon Bridge landfill near Liskeard. In Cornwall we recycle and compost 37% of our waste. Because our residents and recycling collection crews sort out the recycling so carefully, we are able to recycle 99% of the material that we collect in our recycling boxes and sacks. All of the recycling collected in Cornwall is sold in the UK or Europe. We can trace all of the materials from collection to the point that they are made into new products. When Cornwall had six district areas, each authority had its own recycling collection service and contractors. This means that the recycling collection systems vary across Cornwall with each area having different coloured boxes and bags. Over 25% of the black bag waste that is land filled every day is; glass bottles and jars, paper, cardboard, tins and cans and plastic bottles that could easily be recycled. Almost 20% more could be composted in a standard compost bin and a further 18% is avoidable food waste.
