### Independent Custody Visiting Scheme

Website: <http://www.dcpa.police.uk/icv/index.htm> Independent Custody Visitors can also choose to become Police Dog Welfare Volunteers. This involves ICVs attending police stations and the Police Dog Training School at Police Headquarters to report, comment and observe on the conditions of Police dogs within the Constabulary. They then report their findings back to the central Scheme Administrator.

### Changing policing for changing demand

Over the last 30 years the Police have seen a significant reduction in the number of people visiting a station enquiry office (front office). Nearly 90% of all crime is now reported via the telephone and access to the Force website, using mobile data devices. This has increased significantly with over 60,000 hits last month alone. Twenty three public enquiry offices will be retained across Devon and Cornwall opening

from 10:00 –19:00, Tuesday to Friday and 09:00 – 14:00 on a Saturday at the majority of our stations. Members of the public wanting to speak with an officer face to face can always make an appointment by contacting their local neighbourhood policing team on 08452 777444. Chair of the Police Authority, Mike Bull, noted "this modernisation will save the force approximately £5.4 million over 4 years".

## ROAD CLOSURE

The use by through traffic of the length of road from junction west of Plusha to Newton between grid reference 223883:79621 and the junction of the B3257 will be prohibited from **10 to 14 January 2011** (0730 to 1800 hours). This restriction is necessary for patching works.

### Alternative Route

From the south west end of the closure take a northerly turning via Trevague towards the A30. Take a northerly direction towards Five Lanes then take an easterly turning to join the A30. Continue along the A30 then take a north easterly direction along the sliproad towards Kennards House. Take a north easterly turning along the A395 then follow the A395 in a south easterly direction. Take a north westerly direction along the A30 to the junction of the B3257 then take a southerly turning along the B3257 towards the north east end of the closure.

From the north east end of the closure take a north westerly turning along the B3257 then take a westerly direction along the A30. At Five Lanes take the sliproad off the A30 then take an easterly turning via Newhouse to Trevague and the south west end of the closure.
