Lewannick Parish Council News

Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 20 April. Before our ordinary meeting Councillors were invited to meet Alison Gibson who is an area co-ordinator for grant funding within South-East Cornwall. We invited Alison to discuss our plans for the regeneration of Lewannick Playing Area. Her advice was immensely helpful to us. She highlighted the need for a committee that would operate separately from the parish council. The group would need its own constitution and she explained how the South Hill Parish Council have an organization called the South Hill Parish Council Recreation Field Committee (the Organisation). The proposed group would have power to raise funds and to invite and receive contributions, to recruit and support volunteers and to have the ability to raise funds that would not be available to a parish council. The parish council would still be the accountable body and all invoices would be in the name of the parish council. This would ensure that the 20% VAT can be reclaimed. We are now hoping that parents, grandparents and members of our community will come forward and set-up this organization. We are sure that a number of residents would be interested in assisting with this. It is noted that the Organization can also raise monies for adult sports equipment. We hope that interested parties will come forward to regenerate this valuable asset for our community.

We also met up with a representative of Coastline who proved very helpful in assisting us with queries that we have received from some of the new residents. Questions put to Coastline included their future plans, plumbing and general snagging issues together with the street lighting. This meeting also proved immensely informative.

Following on from our invited guests our ordinary meeting began at 20.00 hours. We have an offer of a grant from Cornwall Council with respect to the Local Maintenance Partnership 2011/12 which we are pleased to accept. This will assist us financially with respect to the maintenance of our 17 footpaths.

Planning PA11/02286 Construction of a new single family dwelling with associated car parking bays to road frontage Pen-Inney Cottage, Lewannick, Mr David Eno. This has been supported although we have queried the inadequate parking to the front of the proposed dwelling.

Finance: Our Public Liability Aon £696.70, Cumbria Clock £3,124.80, invoices from David Eno and Helena Novak (with respect to the production of our newsletter) totally £460.00.

Our next meeting will take the form of our Annual General Parish Meeting. We would welcome input from the community. If organizations would like to submit an up-date of the events that have taken place during the last 12 months this would be incorporated within our meeting and updated on our website. Also, of course, we like to hear from organizations within our community as we need to plan our grant funding process. Our AGM will be held at LEWANNICK VILLAGE HALL (the AGM was held at Polyphant last year) and will commence at 19.30 hours on Wednesday 18 May 2011 and will be followed by our Ordinary Meeting. Members of the public are welcome.
