## Lewannick Parish Council News

Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 15 June. Firstly, we had a very useful site meeting with Tarmac and Cornwall Council with respect to the forthcoming sale of Blackhill Quarry. Issues discussed included the current and future opening times, 2006 ROMP report and the conditions appertaining thereto, the closeness to the village of Polyphant and the need for a public consultation if there are any tentative changes to the future operational activities. We concluded that as a council we have had a good relationship of continual consultation with Tarmac with regular meetings and wished for the same relationship to be introduced to a new buyer.

We also enquired about the hedgerow that joins the road and Tarmac confirmed that a survey of all the trees and hedgerow has just taken place and that they had a duty of care to carry out any work recommended following that report.

During our ordinary meeting issues discussed included a site meeting at Lewannick Churchyard where a suitable location for the interment of ashes was confirmed with the churchwarden.

We have received correspondence from Carnewater Practice with respect to a proposed move of their Lewannick Surgery to new premises at Beacon View and we were disappointed to learn that they are not going ahead with this. However, they are fully committed to their existing practice in Lewannick.

The Litter Pickers are continuing to do a very worthwhile job for the parish and are being kept busy. It is noted that there has been a degree of fly tipping but we are pleased to note that the street wardens have been collecting as soon as we have reported any items.

There was one planning application for discussion, namely proposed annex to Medrow Bungalow for Mr Tim Ellis, No PA11/03734. The application has been supported as we feel there is a local need.

We had three invoices for payment, Keith Hopper, £223.32 for the electrical work to the Clock Tower, Lewannick, BJV Cleaning, £22.00 for cleaning of bus shelter and Cumbria Clock £156.00 for the annual service of Lewannick Church Clock.

Finally, Lewannick Parish Church was represented by the Churchwarden at our Annual General Meeting and gave a full update on the Church which was immensely helpful.

Our next meeting is scheduled to take place at Polyphant Village Hall at 20.00 hours on Wednesday 20 July.
