The committee will have the full support and backing of the Parish Council. There are a number of grant sources available for new equipment. We have drawn up plans and have consulted with the users. Could you assist with such a worthwhile project?

We would also like to say a big thank you to the residents within our community who carry out tasks for the benefit of us all. In particular the Litter Pickers who have been working tirelessly throughout our parish and are doing an excellent job.

We also wish to thank Mr and Mrs Cash of Bowden Derra for helping our community by maintaining the grass at Polyphant. The costs of having the green cut had taken up a large percentage of our precept historically and it is not only heartening to have the community backing us in this way but, of course, it will assist us all financially. As previously stated Bowden Derra have a public liability insurance to cover the work that they are doing on a contract basis on behalf of Lewannick Parish Council. This is a fine example of the Government's ethos of the community working together and is proving so beneficial.

On a disappointing note we have had reports that dog fouling is still a problem and once again we have reported your concerns to the Dog Warden. There are a number of bins provided throughout our parish but if there is a problem area with no bin please do let us know.

Our next meeting will take the form of an Ordinary Meeting commencing at 20.00 hours on Wednesday 21 September. As always you are most welcome to join us at Lewannick Village Hall.
