Lewannick Parish Council News

This month our meeting took place at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 21 September 2011. We had planning applications for consideration, namely:- PA11/06591 Works to trees covered by a Tree Preservation Order namely, crown lift mature oak tree to 4.5 m over garden and lift 5m over road, Lanscarrat, Medrow, Polyphant – Mr B Spooner – which was supported. PA11/06086 Proposed demolition of existing store with replacement sustainable living training centre, Bowden Derra Park, Polyphant, Launceston – Mr David Cash. Supported as it is a facility that the business requires. PA11/06614 Application for a Lawful Development Certificate for the continued use of chalet as a residential unit, Trelaske Haven, Trelaske, Mr John White – supported as the unit is well-established.

There were two invoices for payment: production of newsletter £315.00 and Perfect Pastures £640.00.

We have reported a case of Japanese Knotweed at Trevadlock. We have also requested the highways department carry out a further site visit at Trevadlock with respect to our concerns of insufficient run from the drains to storm drains.

We are still in dialogue with Carnewater Practice with respect to the Doctors Surgery and a meeting with relevant parties is being set-up.

As the winter programme lies in front of us we are mindful that salt provisions need to be organised and are pleased to report that we have a volunteer to distribute salt within Lewannick, when required, and we are seeking volunteers to do the same at Polyphant and Trevadlock. The salt provisions will have to be stored at a suitable location for onward spreading as necessary.

Once again we are receiving complaints about dog fouling. Notably this time Polyphant Green. The kind people who cut the grass for free are having to deal with the very unpleasant task of strimming the grass and having dog faeces flying up from the grass cutter. We have a bin located on the green. Please use it. There are fines for this and if caught action will be taken.

On a positive note we are delighted that volunteers are coming forward to help with the regeneration of Lewannick Play Area. The first meeting will be held at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 12 October commencing 20.00 hours.
