Lewannick Parish Council News

Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant on Wednesday 19 October 2011.

There was one planning application for consideration, namely PA11/06702 – erection of affordable home and new vehicular access Location – land west of Glebelands, Old Hill, Lewannick, Launceston, Mr Wayne Francome and Miss Sharon Parnell. The application has the support of the council as it is considered that it meets local need and will be using local services. It is noted that during the decision-making process for this application Cllrs Newbery and Parnell vacated the room, having declared a personal interest.

The Carnewater Practice and Lewannick Surgery – a meeting has been set up with the housing officer and manager of the Carnewater Practice together with County Councillor Phil Parsons in November.

Concerns have been highlighted with respect to traffic using Old Hill, Lewannick and this has caused a number of minor incidents. We have requested an investigation with Highways.

We are sorry to have to report that Councillor Michael Cook has resigned from our council due to health reasons. Michael has been an immense asset to us and during the time that he has been of service he has helped to set up and head the Litter Pickers and to head the Neighbourhood Watch. He has also been a keen supporter at various meetings on behalf of our council. He will be greatly missed and we pass on our very best wishes to him. As a result of this resignation we will, of course, be inviting applicants to fill this valuable role. In the meantime we have notified our Monitoring Officer and the post will be advertised formally. If you are interested in becoming a councillor please do not hesitate to contact one of our councillors who would welcome the opportunity to have a chat to you about your duties within the role.

We are also very pleased to confirm that the Lewannick Regeneration of the Play Area now has a committee and their next meeting is scheduled for 9 November at Lewannick Village Hall commencing at 20.00 hours. Anyone is free to come along to this meeting to assist in supporting the activities of the group.

There were no invoices for payment but it was agreed that all meetings for the Regeneration of the Play Area and for the hire of the hall would be paid by the council.

which you can display. By taking a stand you

you have children teach them it's socially
unacceptable to drop litter. Don't fly tip -
dumping household, industrial and
commercial waste illegally is a serious criminal
offence that carries a fine of up to £20,000
