## Lewannick Parish Council News

Lewannick Parish Council met on Wednesday 16 November at Lewannick Village Hall. Our financial budget for 2011/12 was discussed and it was agreed that our precept will remain as last year, namely £13,200.

It was also agreed that we would promote an awareness day for the regeneration of Lewannick Play Area by hiring a skate park for a day. The event will be organised by the Regeneration of the Play Area Committee.

Cheques for payment included Perfect Pastures £400 for the maintenance of Lewannick Green, £15 for Remembrance Sunday Wreath and Audit Commissioners £162.00 for the completion of our audit for the year ended 31 March 2011. We have also submitted a claim for reimbursement of £200 for the maintenance of the footpaths within our parish to Cornwall Council.

Councillors are keen for a Forum to be set-up in support of the Doctors' Surgery in Lewannick. We have had enquiries from some residents but would like to have this in operation early next year. The group would be a great asset to both Carnewater Practice and, of course, the parish. It is understood that a Forum Group has recently been set-up for the Launceston Health Centre and that it is proving to be very beneficial to the practice and patients. If you would be interested in assisting with a Forum committee and you currently use the Doctors Surgery in Lewannick we would like to hear from you.

As we reported last month, Councillor Michael Cook has had to resign from our Council because of poor health. We, therefore, need to co-opt a new councillor. The co-option would take place at our January meeting which will take place at Polyphant on Wednesday 18 January commencing 20.00 hours. Anyone interested in taking up this role needs to initially apply in writing for the attention of The Clerk, Alisa, Medrow, Polyphant, LAUNCESTON, PL15 7PS. All letters will be submitted to our current team of councillors. We would also need any interested parties to please come to our meeting in January and to give a short introduction about themselves. We will not be holding a meeting in December as is our usual practice. Our next meeting is scheduled for January 18 2012.

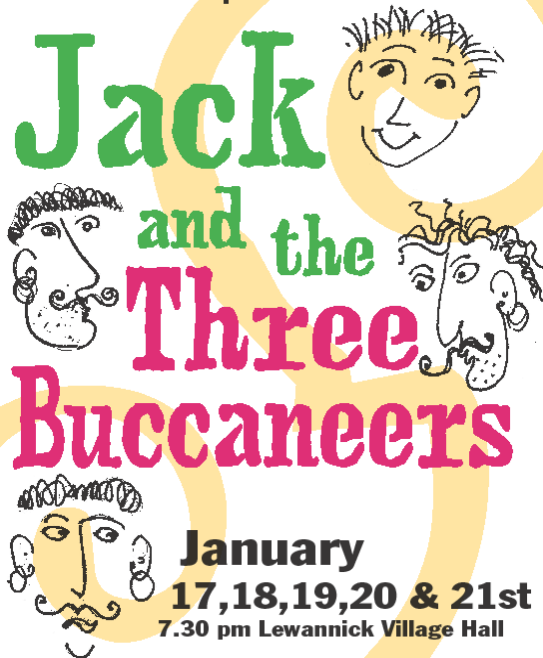
