## Lewannick Parish Council News

Our first meeting for 2012 was held at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 18 January 2012.

We were delighted with the response from residents to come onto the Council and thank all those who forwarded applications to us. Following the co-option process we are pleased to welcome Paul Atkinson, who lives in Lewannick, onto our Council. Paul is involved in a variety of community activities, including the Film Society and the Lewannick Amateur Dramatic Society. He has spent his working life in secondary education and has experience as a governor for many years. He would like to see more younger people in the parish participating within the community and in the work of the Parish Council.

We had three planning applications for consideration, namely:- PA11/10995 Addition of first floor to existing bungalow, Marralameda, Callington Road, Lewannick for Mr and Mrs R North. The application was supported. Also supported was application PA11/10135 Creation of a basement to the Residents' Café (planning permission granted for single storey building in January 2009, Reference: 2008/02231) Bowden Derra Park, Polyphant, Launceston for Mr D Cash. Mr D Turley, 1 Trenhome House, Congdons Shop, Launceston, PL15 7PN, PA11/10897 was not supported for a wind turbine because of visual concerns.

We have a Community Network Meeting scheduled for Thursday 26 January at Launceston Town Hall. This is an opportunity for Councillors to participate in discussions about the issues that are relevant and important to the communities that we represent and is used as a template to shape the focus and priorities for the coming twelve months.

We had one invoice for payment of £120.00 for Perfect Pastures with respect to checking of public footpaths.

We have lobbied our MP, Cornwall Council, Bodmin Moor Parish and Group Travel with respect to the importance of retaining the vital bus service from outlying rural villages to Launceston. We have also requested that Highways deal with the road surface at Landers Lake and the slippery pavement at Medrow, Polyphant. It is good to note that Highways have appeared to put right the reported drainage problem in Trevadlock.

Our next meeting is scheduled to take place at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 15 February commencing 20.00 hours. Members of the public are always welcome to join us.
