Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 21 March 2012. We had two planning applications for discussion, namely: **Application PA12/01581** Proposed extension to form accessible W.C., and external steps leading to first floor flat front door. The Cottage Polyphant LAUNCESTON. The application was not supported because it is considered to be a further extension to an already unsympathetic extension of an existing cottage. All were in favour. **Application PA11/10897** Wind Turbine, Mr Turley, Trenthorne which has come back to us following re-positioning of the proposed turbine. It was agreed that we would not support this application on a 5-3 vote as it was considered a blot on the landscape. We also had an invoice from Taylor Made of £196.80 with respect to the purchase of two swing seats for Lewannick Play Area and £55.00 for Polyphant Church with respect to hiring of the hall. We have written to Carnewater Practice with the names of interested parties to set-up a Forum. Further interested parties would be welcome as we currently have four to set-up this group. Please let us know if you could help with this valuable and interesting group. We have agreed to gift Jubilee mugs to children within our parish who are 16 and under. Jubilee mugs will also be available for parishioners to purchase. The village hall car park at Lewannick is in an urgent state of repair. We have agreed to go ahead and tarmac the entrance to the hall car park on behalf of the parish. We have also requested repairs to be carried out to Lewannick Play Area in time for the May Day Celebrations. Finally, we invited Mr Fox from the Devon and Cornwall Probation Service, who gave an interesting talk on the delivery of services that are available to the community. Dog fouling is still a serious problem and we urge dog owners to consider the people who cut our grass and help to keep the parish looking so beautiful. Please pick up and use the number of bins that are provided throughout the parish. Also litter – we have further volunteers to assist with litter picking which is very gratefully appreciated. However, all residents need to be vigilant and assist in keeping our parish litter free. Our next ordinary meeting will be held on 18 April, 8pm, at Lewannick Village Hall. Members of the public are always welcome.
