

Lewannick Polyphant & Trevadlock Newsletter

Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 21 March. Prior to the meeting Councillors attended a site meeting at the proposed site for the Tinney Hall Farm solar application. We were pleased that we had a strong presence from members of the public at our meeting, who were there in part to voice their concerns with respect to the proposed planning application **PA12/02869** for the installation and operation of a solar farm. Following the support of residents, parish council and our county councillor we are pleased to confirm that the applicant **Lightsource have withdrawn their application** submitted on 23 March 2012. Having listened to people's concerns at a further meeting scheduled by the parish council and held at Lewannick on Monday 23 April, Lightsource have written and confirmed. **We have decided to withdraw the planning application and will no longer proceed with this site.** They confirmed a letter to Cornwall Council setting out their withdrawal. **Having listened to people's concerns at last night's meeting (Monday 23 April), viewed the site, and in particular the views to the site from the road approaching the village, we decided that in this particular instance the potential for adverse visual impacts was more significant than we had anticipated based on the studies we had undertaken. We will notify residents of Lewannick with a mail out.** They wished to let us know as soon as possible, as this may have implications for our Extraordinary Meeting scheduled for Friday 27 April. Our Extraordinary Meeting was, of course, cancelled as a result of the decision. Further residents were present to put forward their ideas for the forthcoming Jubilee celebrations within our parish and it was agreed that the Parish Council will distribute Jubilee mugs to all children 16 and under at the time of the Jubilee. Further mugs will, of course, be available for residents to purchase. We are also pleased to report that repairs have been undertaken at Lewannick Play Area and following inspection on 25 April we can confirm that the play area is now once again open. We are also pleased to report that the contract to resurface the car park at Lewannick, commissioned by the parish council, has been completed and has greatly improved the site. We had planning applications for our consideration **PA12/03013** Mount Pleasant, Medrow, Mrs Jennifer Potter for the construction of a garden shed which was supported. Also application **PA12/02879** Mr Ian Scott conversion of barn to a dwelling, together with the erection of an extension, Blackaton Farm, Lewannick which was also supported. Thanks are extended to our team of litter pickers. It is noted that where litter is being picked on a regular basis it is certainly having an impact and improves the appearance of our parish greatly. Thank you.

Finally our Annual General Meeting will take place in May. The meeting will be held at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 16th May 2012 at 19.30. We would appreciate reports from organizations within our parish either written or by representation.
