PARISH COUNCIL MEETING ON 28th November 1996.

Drivers of vehicles using the Two Bridges junction onto the A30 from Old Hill are requested not to cross the South bound (to Bodmin) carriageway to join the northbound (to Launceston) unless the central crossing area is clear of other vehicles. Of late, the Police have reported two or more vehicles using the crossing point at the same time which is potentially very dangerous.
