Our Annual General Meeting took place on Wednesday 16 May. We were pleased to have representatives/reports from Lewannick Church, Lewannick Regeneration of Playground, Lewannick Film Society, History, Amateur Dramatics, Over 50's, Litter Pickers and Polyphant Ladies Club and we would like to extend our thanks to all parties for their contribution. Our Chairman John Newbery has now served for four years and as per our standing orders stands down. The Council are extremely grateful for the superb leadership that John has demonstrated and extend their sincere thanks to him for the hard work and dedication that he has consistently delivered in this demanding role. A new Chairperson has yet to be elected. There were two members of the Council who were unable to attend our AGM and it was agreed that we will hold an extraordinary meeting prior to our ordinary meeting scheduled for 19<sup>th</sup> June in order to appoint our new Chair and Vice Chair. We have recently had a site visit by CC for a tree located in the play area at Polyphant. Sadly we have to report that the brace securing the tree, fitted on the advice of our County Forester, has been removed by an unknown party. The tree, as a result, is dividing and we are waiting to receive advice with respect to the future of this otherwise healthy tree. Needless to say, we are very disappointed that someone has deliberately done this. Particularly as the tree has a preservation order and work can only be carried out with permission. Whilst on site the CC member also examined the exit at Bowden Derra onto the village green, Polyphant, where there are a number of large potholes and road markings have, in parts, diminished as a result of, at times, heavy surface water. We have been advised that this matter is in hand. We also had a site meeting at Beacon View with respect to trees and again are waiting for advice from CC. We had a number of planning applications for decision: PA12/03937 Application to pollard main limb union at the top of the trunk to Oak Tree subject to a tree
