

# Lewannick, Polyphant & Trevadlock Newsletter

Lewannick Parish Council met on Wednesday 20 June 2012 at 19.30 for our Extraordinary Meeting. The purpose of this meeting was to appoint a Chairperson and Vice, together with officers for affiliated responsibilities. We are pleased to confirm that Councillor Adrian Brown has been voted on as our new Chairperson. Adrian has a young family that attend Lewannick School and he has served on our council for over five years. David Parnell has been appointed as our Vice Chairperson. David has a wealth of experience as a Councillor and lives and works within the parish. John Newbery is our Officer for Lewannick Play Area, Jenny Pottery for Polyphant Play Area, John Panter for Litter Pickers and David Eno the officer for Lewannick Historical Group together with Lewannick Website. Following our Extraordinary Meeting we held our Ordinary Meeting at 20.00. It was agreed that we will employ Cormac to inspect, plot and record trees on the Cornwall Council tree database and provide reports containing safety and management advice. This inventory data and record can then be updated during subsequent inspections. Our contract for the maintenance of Polyphant Green was also reviewed and it was agreed that the grass was being cut at the right time taking into account highway safety and use of the location for amenity events. Planning, all of which has been supported, included PA12/0409 25 Hawks Tor Drive, Lewannick Mr and Mrs Oldaker, Single Storey Lounge and Integral Garage Extension, PA12/05235 Alterations to bathroom roof. Bodeglos, Old Hill, Lewannick, Mr and Mrs Hunt and PA12/04617 Demolition of existing temporary classroom unit and erection of a single storey classroom extension, with link corridor. Lewannick Community Primary School, Hawks Tor Drive, Lewannick. Financially we have received cheques from Westcountry Housing of £150.00 towards the Jubilee Celebrations and £9.12 from Western Power Distribution for a Wayleave payment. Invoices for payment Aon Insurance £712.20 and Kenetic Designs £468.00 for Jubilee mugs to all children within the parish. Grants have been awarded to Trevadlock Cemetary maintenance £150.00, Lewannick Church £500.00, Polyphant Church £250.00, Lewannick Dramatic Society £200.00, Launceston Over 50's £300.00, Lewannick Website £200.00, Lewannick Historical Group £200 and Lewannick Play Park Regeneration £200. We have received letters of thanks from Trevadlock, Polyphant and Lewannick with respect to the Jubilee Celebrations. There is a Cornwall Renewable Energy Show at the former Gaia Centre, Delebole and members have indicated that they wished to attend. Our next meeting is scheduled to take place at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 18 July commencing at 20.00. The meeting is open to members of the public.
