Lewannick Parish Council held an Extraordinary Meeting on Wednesday 8 August 2012. PA12/06166 proposed infill extension to create a garden room, Bowden Derra Park, Polyphant, Launceston, PL15 7PU – Mr David Cash Park Properties. PA12/04436 importation and recycling of inert waste to create WRAP protocol secondary aggregates for the construction market - Mr Tim Payne Walton Civil Engineering. Both applications were supported. There was an opportunity for members of the public to ask questions and representatives for both applications were also present. We also signed documentation relating to Lewannick Play Park Regeneration and Cornwall Development Company regarding funding of £8,400 from East Cornwall LAG. Finally, it was agreed that we would again advertise for the maintenance of the public footpaths throughout our parish. We have advertised in the Cornish and Devon Post in order to create awareness from interested parties. A decision on instruction of the footpath maintenance will be made at our September meeting. If there is anyone in the parish interested in taking up the maintenance of the footpaths please do not hesitate to contact us. Our next meeting is scheduled to take place at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday September 19th at 8:00pm.
