Lewannick Parish Council

met at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 19 September. **Planning applications**, which were supported, were: PA12/06694 Construction of cottage style dwelling to serve equestrian business and demolition of existing dwelling granted certificate of lawfulness for existing residential use under application No. PA11/06614 Trelaske Haven, Lewannick, Mr John White. PA12/07331 Conversion of existing Mill building and erection of new double garage. Trelaske Mill, Lewannick, Launceston, PL15 7QQ for Mr Richard Henderson. **Invoices for payment** comprised Audit Commission £162.00 for the auditing of our accounts for the year ended 31 March 2012, Cornish and Devon Post £51.86 advertising vacancy for footpath maintenance and Stuart Parnell £539.65 for repairs and painting of benches in parish, replacing wooden notice board in Polyphant and painting notice boards at Lewannick and Polyphant. We have also accepted a quotation for the maintenance of the footpaths (17) through our parish of £600 for the first cut of styles and paths. There has been a **request for a bus shelter** at Lewannick and we are in discussion with Highways. If a suitable location can be found, the request is for a shelter to be located near to Hawks Tor/Harpers Meadow. **Lewannick Regeneration of Play Area** have also received promises of grant funding from Tesco (donation of a bench), Archer Arms £200 and Bowden Derra £250. We have had concerns raised that **vehicles are going up Old Hill**, Lewannick from the A30. If residents are confronted by a vehicle incorrectly using this section of road can they try and log the time, make and registration of vehicle and forward to us. Also, if residents are confronted by **Lorries cutting through Polyphant** can they please note the time, make and registration of lorry and let us have this so that we can maintain an audit trail and take the necessary action. **Our newsletter would benefit from items of news within the parish.** If you run an organization or have an item that may be of interest to the parish please email news@lewannick.info.
