

Lewannick Polyphant & Trevadlock Newsletter

Lewannick Parish Council held their meeting at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 17 October. We had three planning applications for consideration. **PA12/08027** Relocation of proposed sustainable Living Training Centre Mr D Cash has been supported as we considered that the training centre will be a positive contribution to the lives of the residents, the dwelling is already in existence and cannot be seen from Polyphant village green. Application **PA12/08611** Installation of 1 Bergey Excel micro wind turbine mounted on a 20m to hub open lattice tower with three blades and a rotor diameter of 7m on land near Trenhorne (Blackberry Farm, Congdons Shop) for Mr and Mrs P and L Grimshaw – a decision has not been made. We have requested an extension together with a clearer location plan prior to forming an opinion and our decision will be sent back before 8th November. We also are having a site visit in respect of application **PA12/09171** Mr I Scott, Blackaton, Lewannick, for the erection of a single 500kw wind turbine, 50m to hub, 77m to tip, together with associated works and formation of access track to serve the development. We will make our decision on this application at our November meeting. We commissioned a survey to be carried out on all the trees on Polyphant Green. The survey is now under consideration with Polyphant Residents Association prior to our submitting a planning application to carry out the works contained therein. We have investigated complaints received with respect to lorries going through the village of Polyphant from Blackhill Quarry. We have been assured that the contractor was told not to go through the village and it is understood that the particular contract has now been completed. We have also requested a visible presence by our community police officer throughout the parish and in particular at Old Hill, Lewannick where vehicles are still using the no entry hill to cut through to Lewannick. We urge anyone who observes this to please take as much detail as possible including number plate, type of vehicle and time. Finally, we are in consultation with Highways with respect to a further bus shelter for Lewannick. Our next meeting will take place at Lewannick on Wednesday 21 November commencing 20.00 hours. Members of the public are always most welcome to join us and the first part of our meeting is always open for you to share your views or concerns.
