

Lewannick Polyphant & Trevadlock Newsletter

Lewannick parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on 21st November. There were members of the public present who queried an application for a wind turbine at Blackaton, Lewannick ref PA12/0971. There were also members of the public present who questioned Footpath no.7 Lewannick, part of which is not shown on the definitive map. It was decided that the section missing from the map would not be pursued. We have submitted our application for work to be carried out on the trees at Polyphant and we are waiting for the planning process before requesting tenders to carry out the work. We are pleased to confirm that our precept remains at £12,000. We are also pleased to support the Regeneration of Lewannick Play Area with financial assistance of £921.79 towards the fencing, together with £2,982 for an additional swing that will complete the area. Planning applications which have been supported comprise:- PA12/0971 Erection of a single 500kw wind turbine, 50m to hub, 77m to tip, together with associated works and formation of access track to serve the development, Mr I Scott. Blackaton, Lewannick PL15 7QS. PA12/09673 Change of use of land from stationing of 2 mobile holiday homes to stationing of 2 park homes for permanent residential use. Units 1 and 2 Trevadlock Hall Park, Vowles Parks Ltd. PA12/09433 construction of a field shelter, Mrs Diana Morton, 10 Medrow, Polyphant. Our next meeting is scheduled to take place at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 16th January commencing at 20:00. As always members of the public are welcome to attend and the first ten minutes of each meeting is available for residents to raise any issues. Finally we extend our very best wishes to you all for Christmas.

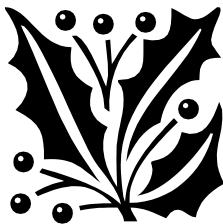
