

Lewannick Polyphant & Trevadlock Newsletter

Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant on Wednesday 16th January. Planning applications for decision included: PA12/09684 Alterations and extension to dwelling Dingleys Cottage, Lewannick, Mr M Parnell – Supported. PA12/12097 Change of use from paddock to residential dwelling with vehicular access, Trecoombe, Polyphant, Mr N Ponting – Supported due to local need. PA12/11490 Construction of a multi-purpose agricultural shed, North Downs, Polyphant, Mrs Shirley Jasper – Supported as no impact on the landscape and not visible from the highway. PA12/12043 Erection of a single wind turbine with a maximum tip height of 35m for the purpose of exporting renewable energy to the national grid, Trewanta Park, Lewannick, Mr W Doble, Cleanearth energy – Not supported, considered would have an impact on the landscape, is inefficient and would have a negative impact on tourism. Finally PA12/10366 Trelaske Cottage, Lewannick – Supported as we consider it will make a more functional family home.

Invoices for payment included Perfect Pastures £1,200 for the maintenance of Lewannick Green, and Schoolscapes £31,044.88 part payment of Lewannick Play Park. We are in the process of receiving grant funding from ECLAG and SITA.

A bus shelter for Lewannick is also being pursued. We have requested that Highways and our County Councillor discuss an appropriate location with residents prior to proceeding with a grant funding application. The potholes within the parish are being identified so that an up-to-date listing can be furnished to Highways.

The maintenance of the Village Green at Polyphant is on our radar. We have an application for work to be carried out on the trees later this summer. We have also had a request from the Residents' Association for some remedial works to be carried out to improve the durability of the Green and a site meeting with Councillors is scheduled to examine this.

Our website has been updated and we plan to post all forthcoming items onto our agenda, as they become available, thus keeping our Parish fully informed of matters in hand. We wish to say a big thank you to the many residents within the Parish who have been so proactive with the distribution of salt during the snow and ice. Also to the residents who help pick up our litter. Thank you.

Our next ordinary meeting is scheduled for Wednesday 20th February at 20:00 at Lewannick. Members of the public are always very welcome to attend.
