Lewannick Parish Council

Our last meeting was held at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 20 February. The proposed bus shelter for Lewannick was discussed. At the time of our meeting we were still waiting for a quotation from Cormac. The quotation has, since our meeting, been received and we are pleased to confirm that our application has been submitted. It is anticipated that, **subject to funding**, a suitable bus shelter will be installed soon. We have received concerns that the dog bins are not being emptied sufficiently and we are pursuing this. We have also reminded Blackhill Quarry that their hedge requires urgent attention.

We are delighted with the new Play Park and the wonderful community spirit that has helped to make this happen. We have sent our cheque to Schoolscape in the sum of £17,796.90 making a total payment of £51,904.80. We have also had the park inspected by Rospa prior to our planned opening.

There are a number of pot holes throughout our parish and we have made Highways aware of this.

There were two planning applications for discussion, namely PA13/00536 Maintenance works to trees protected by a TPO as set out in schedule of works submitted with the application. In addition works to T12 – crown reduce by 2 metres and crown raise all around by 2 metres and T73 consider felling as in a play area. Consultation with Polyphant Residents Association formed part of our planning process – we have of course supported this application. PA13/00596 Construction of dwelling land adjacent to 21 Cottage Garden, Lewannick, Launceston Mr and Mrs J Symons – it was felt that the plans fitted in with surrounding properties, is in an unobtrusive position and there is a need for more local housing – supported.

Our next meeting will take place at Polyphant on Wednesday 20 March commencing at 20.00 and as always members of the public are welcome to attend.
