Lewannick Parish Council

Our meeting was held at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 17th April and commenced at 20:00. We were pleased to receive members of the public. There were no questions raised. It was agreed that prior to our AGM, which is scheduled to take place on Wednesday 15th May at Polyphant Village Hall, that Councillors would conduct a site visit of Polyphant Green. This will be in order to examine the Green and respond to Polyphant Residents Association with respect to their requests for salt bin/weathered stones. We have, following requests from a number of users of the local bus service, consulted Highways with regards to the siting of a further bus shelter for Lewannick. We have had two site visits with Highways in order to ascertain a safe position for a shelter. The proposed bus shelter would be maintained by the Parish Council and the proposed location is on the common land, Hawks Tor, Lewannick. This is subject to receiving grant funding, which has been applied for. With respect to Lewannick Play Park, it is rewarding to note how much the park is enjoyed by everyone. There are some minor works that need to be carried out to the mound, and it is necessary to close the park for a limited period to carry out those works. However, we are indebted to the Play Park Committee and other residents for their goodwill and support in helping us to ensure that the Park is back in operation as soon as possible. We have to say farewell to three councillors who are standing down prior to the forthcoming elections in May. Eric Sleep, Bernard O'Neil and John Panter. They have served the community well and we thank them for their hard work and commitment they have given to our Parish. Our County Councillor Phil Parsons is also standing down. He has been a tremendous help to us all. We thank him for all he has done and wish them all well for the future. The town and parish council elections will take place on 2nd May. We hope you will all exercise your vote. There are 10 seats and 12 candidates, namely Paul Atkinson, Adrian Brown, Susan Curley, David Eno, Sue Gallant (incorrectly listed as Gallast), John Newbery, Monica Palmer, David Parnell, Katie Parnell, Jenny Potter, Barbara Sleep and Michael White. The electorate are able to vote for up to and including 10 candidates. Planning applications for consideration were: PA13/02465 Listed Building Consent for the installation of 2 solar panel arrays on south and west roofs. Jasmine Cottage, Polyphant, Mr Christopher Baverstock. The application was not supported as it is in a conservation area with a significant historical importance. PA13/01561 Listed Building Consent to remove glass and aluminium frame and replace with wooden frames on conservatory. Jasmine Cottage, Polyphant, Mr Christopher Baverstock. Supported as it is considered an improvement. PA13/01691 Conversion of existing garage to en suite bathroom and office/study. Sally Ross, Trecoombe. Polyphant, Launceston – supported. There were two invoices for payment. Cornish and Devon Post £69.84 ref advertising for tree work, Polyphant. Cornwall Association of Local Councils £269.73 ref our subscription. The tenders for works to be carried out on Polyphant Green were considered. A tender has now been accepted and the works will commence on 5th August 2013, weather permitting. Finally, our Annual Parish Meeting will be held on Wednesday 15th May at Polyphant Village Hall. We would request all organisations within our parish to kindly submit their report summarising events that have taken place during the year, Furthermore we would welcome your attendance.
