We now have a council that has been voted on by the parish. We wish to thank the candidates who stood but who were not elected as they helped to make this democratic process possible. The council met at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 15th May.

ELECTION OF CHAIRPERSON AND VICE CHAIRPERSON

Following our election the position of Chairperson and Vice Chairperson were considered and a vote taken. Our new Chairperson is Adrian Brown, as previous, and our new Vice Chairperson is Barbara Sleep. The meeting commenced at 19.30 with our Annual Parish Meeting. Reports were read out from Lewannick Film Society, Lewannick History Group, Launceston Over 50's Voice, Lewannick Play Area, Polyphant Play Area, Lewannick Village Hall, Polyphant Ladies Group and the Litter Pickers. Our accounts for the year ended 31st March 2013 were also discussed together with a breakdown of our income and expenditure. Our records will now be forwarded to our external auditors Grant Thornton for the annual audit.

PROPOSED BUS SHELTER FOR LEWANNICK

Some immediate residents to the location have written opposing the siting of the bus shelter. However, it is our intention to go ahead with the erection of a shelter subject to grant funding. Although there has been some opposition to a bus shelter we have also received many requests for same.

TRAFFIC SPEEDING THROUGH LEWANNICK

We are in the process of consultation with Lewannick Primary School and hope to develop an awareness plan with their assistance.

LITTER PICKERS

We are forever grateful to our Litter Pickers for the valuable work that they do on our behalf. We have written to Cory asking if they could give further attention to the collection of our waste. It is evident that on collection dates there is a lot of waste that comes out of the sacks and is unfortunately deposited onto the highway. We hope that all residents are careful in ensuring that the waste that they leave out is placed securely, particularly when the weather is windy.

PLANNING

There was one application for discussion PA13/02836 Construction of a dwelling (resubmission of PA13/00596) land south of 21 Cottage Gardens, Lewannick Mr and Mrs J Symons – the application was previously supported and we were of the same opinion – it has been supported.

FINANCE

Invoices for payment included The Cumbria Clock Company Ltd £156.00, Rospa Report for Polyphant and Lewannick Play Areas £170.40, Cornwall Council £570.00 for the tree report Polyphant Green and Turf £156.00 for Lewannick Play Area.

Our next meeting is scheduled to take place at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 19th June. The meeting will be an Ordinary Meeting and as always we invite members of the public to attend. During the course of our June meeting the grants that we give out to for various organisations within our parish will be considered.
