

# Lewannick, Polyphant & Trevadlock Newsletter

## Lewannick Parish Council

Our Ordinary Meeting was held on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June at Lewannick Village Hall. Our Chairman was pleased to introduce and welcome our new County Councillor Vivian Hall. We were also pleased to welcome members of the public.

### PLANNING

Planning applications for discussion included:

PA13/04613 Mrs Diana Mason. Proposed Porch extension and alterations to the existing garage at 10 Medrow, Polyphant. We supported this application. We considered that the application would improve the property. It would also make good use of the footprint and would not be obtrusive to neighbouring properties.

PA13/04572 Mr & Mrs Wadge. Listed building consent to re-roof the house with weathered rag slates on south elevation and reuse existing slates on north elevation, slate hang west and east gable ends with rag slate, replace asbestos sheets on garage with rag slate, rebuild east chimney and repair west chimney and re-hang modern extension with rag slate. We supported this application. We considered that the applicant is improving the property sympathetically and appropriately and has taken into account the character of the dwelling.

PA13/03093 Michael Sandcock. Proposed installation of a 20kw turbine, with steel tower, on agricultural land. We considered that the applicant had presented an extremely good case for the installation and will be supporting the government directive for green energy and it is with these considerations that we were pleased to support the application.

PA13/0361 Proposed garage/bedroom at Galvayne, Lewannick. We did not support this application. We considered that the application dwarfs the original property, the ridge height is too high and would equate to a loss of daylight to the neighbouring property. Moreover, the plans demonstrate a separate dwelling rather than an extension.

### AWARENESS OF PLANNING APPLICATIONS

We robustly advertise all planning applications on our notice boards together with our website – providing they are received prior to our meetings. Applications received up to and including the day of our scheduled meetings are always considered. Cornwall Council advertise all applications within the Cornish & Devon Post and, of course, pink notices are displayed at the location. We consistently invite members of the public to attend our meetings. We encourage applicants who have planning applications coming up to attend our meetings. We always allocate the first ten minutes of our meetings for members of the public to discuss any matters, and that includes planning applications. However, we cannot canvass applicants or parishioners to attend our meetings for a particular subject. Councillors have and do remain neutral. If any resident wishes to discuss a particular subject in confidence with a councillor we will be delighted to listen.

### BUS SHELTER – LEWANNICK

We are pleased to confirm that we now have written confirmation of grant funding. We have now submitted our order with Cormac. We will update you as to when the works will commence.
