Lewannick Parish Council

Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 15 January 2014. The meeting was scheduled for 20.00 and members of the public were invited to attend.

HIGHWAYS – Our Chairman confirmed that he had had a meeting with a representative from Highways with respect to traffic speeding through Lewannick. An invitation has been extended to Highways to attend our next meeting in February in order for us to progress this.

POT HOLES – We have organised for a gang from Highways to attend to the number of potholes throughout our parish. It is understood that this will be addressed as we go to print. If any resident is aware of any potholes that have not been filled in can they kindly contact us.

FLOODING – Again we have been in liaison with Highways and have dealt with specific areas as they have arisen through December and January.

MOBILE LIBRARY SERVICE – We are lobbying various parties with regard to the possible suspension of this service. We have expressed our concern that there has been no consultation and that as a rural parish the service is an important social and amenity link for our community.

FLY TIPPING – There has been three incidents of fly tipping that we have recently reported. One at Old Hill with respect to vehicle parts, one near Two Bridges whereby items, including old electrical appliances, have been dumped and finally large tyres near Blackhill Quarry. We have some information with respect to the offenders. It would be useful if everyone can be watchful of fly tipping. If you observe any vehicle that has stopped and there is an incident of unloading rubbish in our countryside do take their registration number, time that you saw the incident and colour of vehicle. We are making every effort to trace the offenders.

BUS SHELTER, LEWANNICK – We have had so many positive comments and thanks from residents with respect to the bus shelter. It has proved invaluable to residents during this heavy rainfall. The shelter will be cleaned and maintained on a regular basis.

PARISH CLOCK – LEWANNICK CHURCH – It has been agreed that our next project is to have the parish clock auto-regulated. As many of you will be aware the parish clock was gifted to the parish in remembrance of the men who fought in the First World War. As a mark of respect of this centenary year of the First World War it was agreed that improvements would be carried out to the parish clock. It is anticipated that the work will be carried out at the end of February.

POLYPHANT GREEN – We have had an incident in December whereby an ash tree blew slightly over and was partly uprooted as a result of the extreme weather conditions. We did report this. Obtained the obligatory 5 day notices and photographic evidence. The tree has subsequently been felled and made safe by our tree surgeon.

DOG FOULING – It is unfortunate that we have to report that there are still incidences of dog fouling within our parish. In particular, Polyphant Green. We have various people who help us by carrying out work on the green. Let us help them do their work in the knowledge that the public areas are safe and clean to work in.

Our next meeting is scheduled to take place at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 19 February commencing 20.00 hours. Members of the public are always very welcome to join us.

Finally, thank you to Emma Ryan, who is our new editor. Her assistance in providing our newsletter is greatly appreciated by us all.
