PARISH COUNCIL

Lewannick Parish Council met at Polyphant Village Hall on Wednesday 19 March 2014. Prior to the ordinary meeting we were pleased to welcome County Councillor Adam Paynter. Adam had been invited to our meeting to discuss the mobile library.

Former Councillor Michael Cook

Councillors were saddened to hear that former Councillor Michael Cook, following illness, had passed away. A minutes silence took place at the commencement of our meeting as a mark of respect. Our sympathy is extended to his wife. The funeral will take place on Monday 31st March 2014.

Polyphant Green - concerns have been raised with respect to vehicles that are cutting up parts of the green. We are in the process of consulting with the residents association and specialists for advice on how to preserve the conservation area.

We have also reported to the Environmental Agency together with South West Water the presence of a foul drainage smell within the location.

Planning - PA14/01623 Application for works to trees subject to Tree Preservation Order, namely coppicing of Sycamore Tree (T2), Crown Lift 3 Sycamore Trees (T1, T3 and T4) to 4 metres and re-coppice 2 Sycamore Trees (T5 and T6). Polyphant House. Applicant Mr Graham Dodd. The application was supported by LPC. For information: PA124/01785 Various Tree Works - T25 (Sycamore) to be felled and T26 (twin stem Cypress) to be felled. Polyphant House, Polyphant, Miss Jane Roberts.

Finance - an invoice from Polyphant Methodist Chapel £36 and Launceston Printing Company £180 for the production of our newsletters were paid.

River Inney - we have been alerted that there is a plant (looks similar to Cow Parsley but pink known as Hemlock) that has entered the river near Polyphant. It is understood that the plant can be fatal to livestock and animals. Sadly there has been an incident recently.

Next meeting - our next meeting is scheduled to take place at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 16 April commencing 20.00 hours. Members of the public are always welcome to attend.
