LEWANNICK PARISH COUNCIL

Lewannick Parish Council met at Lewannick Village Hall on Wednesday 23 April 2014. The meeting commenced at 20.00 hours and was open to the public to share their viewpoints.

We have heard from South West Water with respect to the foul drainage smell on Polyphant Green. South West Water have confirmed that the matter is under investigation and they will come back to us as soon as the matter has been resolved.

The Parish Clock has had work carried out so that it now automatically regulates.

We are consistently lobbying highways with respect to the number of pot holes through-out the parish and are pleased to note that work has now begun at Trelaske. Nevertheless, we have reminded highways of the number of pot holes that require urgent attention throughout our parish.

Lewannick and Polyphant Play Areas - each year we request Rospra to carry out a survey on both locations. They have recently carried out their annual survey on our behalf and have highlighted areas that require attention. We have subsequently written to the suppliers of the equipment at Lewannick Play Area for their recommendations.

PLANNING

PA14/02035 Variation of condition 2 on decision PA13/04848 dated 22.7.2013 to allow amendment to approved plans to include a link between Rosewood House and café and a balcony to the café. This application has been supported as it would be beneficial to both service users and visitors.

PA14/02495 Various management works to trees covered by a Tree Preservation Order Lewannick Manor has been supported for safety and to preserve the other trees.

PA14/02490 Formation of agricultural access road. Westside, Blackaton, Lewannick, Launceston, PL15 7QS. Mr I Scott. Supported as it will give a continuation of the existing road.

First Step Homes - land for Affordable Local Needs in Lewannick Parish have written to us asking for our comments. It was agreed that we would write to First Step Homes confirming that there is no need for further development at this time. The infrastructure to support the housing being over-full.
